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Panel Identified Critical Factors in Upgrading to a Modern Claims System or RMIS Solution

Claims and Risk Management Executives Shared Lessons Learned and Key Criteria When Shopping for a New System

- Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) with external agencies and other service providers
- Compliance with various state and federal requirements
- Powerful reporting and data analysis capabilities
- Workflow management and automation
